- ✓ Fruit & Vegetable Garden Waste
- ✓ Tree Branches (6 foot length x 6 inch diameter) Paper Plant Pots

### Non Accepted Materials

- ❖ Stumps & Root Balls
- ❖ Driveway & Road Sweepings
- ❖ Kitchen Food Waste
- ❖ Loose Dirt or Topsoil
- ❖ Rocks & Stones
- ❖ Animal Droppings (Kitty Litter, Pet Waste, Manure)
- ❖ Plant Pots (Plastic, Cell Packs, etc.)
- ❖ Plastic & Biodegradable Bags With Yard Waste Wood (Pressure Treated, Stained, Painted)
